EXCESS ON 06/30/01: The amount of contributions (tax paid minus (-) the benefits charged) to your account from the chargeable date shown above. A minus (-) sign indicates the amount of benefits charged was greater than the amount of contributions paid.

CONTRIBUTIONS: The amount of all contributions (tax) paid from July 1, 2001 through July 31, 2002 for the quarters ending September 30, 2001; December 31, 2001; March 31, 2002 and June 30 2002 and the amount of any contribution payments made for prior quarters during this time period.

TOTAL BENEFIT CHARGES: The amount of unemployment insurance benefits charged to your employer account from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

EXCESS ON 06/30/02: The amount of contributions (tax) paid minus (-) the benefits charged. This includes the excess calculated for 06/30/01 and for the one-year period ending 06/30/02. A minus (-) sign indicates the amount of benefits charged was greater than the amount of contributions paid.

RESERVE RATIO: The reserve ratio is the total excess on 06/30/02 divided by (+) the average taxable wages, and is shown as a percentage. If the reserve is .00 see reverse.

ANNUAL TAXABLE WAGES: The amount of wages on which you paid unemployment contributions (tax) in 2001.

TAXABLE WAGES OF ALL PRECEDING EMPLOYERS: A cumulative total consisting of the amount of your annual taxable wages, plus the amount of the annual taxable wages of all other employers preceding you on the list.

PERCENT OF TAXABLE WAGES: The cumulative taxable wages divided by (+) the total taxable wages for all employers in the reserve ratio list. (See ARRAY TABLE information for further explanation.)

RATE: The rate category is determined by the cumulative wages percentage limits in Column B of the RATE TABLE (See Other Side). Each contribution category is identified by the contribution category number in Column A that is opposite the figures in Column B, which represent the percentage limits of each contribution category. If an employer's taxable wages falls in more than one contribution category, the employer must be assigned to the lower-numbered contribution category, except that an employer may not be assigned to a higher contribution category than is assigned any other employer with the same reserve ratio.
